A grade of “C” or better, or a “Pass” in a Pass/Fail transcribed course must be achieved to receive transfer credit.

All students must complete:

- A minimum of 121 semester hours (combination of courses at community college and TU) completed.
- A minimum of 4Z semester hours completed at a 4-year institution with 30 of these semester hours being completed with Tiffin University.
